For the first decade of her career Leigh appeared as the stereotypical "nice girl." She was cast opposite some of the industry's biggest names including Robert Mitchum in *Holiday Affair*, Stewart Granger in *Scaramouche*, James Stewart in *The Naked Spur*, and Charlton Heston in *Touch of Evil*. Alfred Hitchcock's *Psycho* supplied her most memorable role: Marion Crane, who is murdered before the picture is half over. The part earned Leigh an Academy Award nomination. From 1951 to 1962, Leigh was married to favorite co-star Tony Curtis. They had two daughters, Kelly and Jamie Lee Curtis, both of whom followed in their parents' professional footsteps.
