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Flexor Tendon Injuries An Issue

Consistent, successful management of flexor tendon injuries relies on understanding the anatomy, characteristics and repair of tendons in the different zones, potential complications, rehabilitation protocols, recent advances in treatment, and future directions, including tissue engineering and biologic modification of the repair site.

Unfortunately, injuries can develop with your flexor tendons. The most frequent cause of flexor tendon injuries occurs if you experience a cut in the fingertips or the palm of your hand. This can be problematic since your tendons are located adjacent to your skin.

The most common signs of a flexor tendon injury include: An open injury, such as a cut, on the palm side of your hand, often where the skin folds as the finger bends An inability to bend one or more joints of your finger Pain when your finger is bent

Most commonly, a flexor tendon injury results from lacerations (cuts). A laceration to the forearm, hand or wrist can result in injury to the flexor tendons. When a flexor tendon injury happens there can be inability to bend the fingers, thumb or wrist.

The most frequent injury to a flexor tendon is via a laceration, although traumatic rupture of flexor tendons can occur from various etiologies. As with most issues in emergency medicine, an accurate history is the first step in beginning to determine the extent of any injury.

The horse's digital flexor tendons have evolved to store energy, absorb shock, and support weight-bearing joints. Researchers have reported SDFT injuries as the most common type of tendon/ligament injury. In one study of British racehorses and National Hunt horses, SDFT injuries accounted for up to 90% of tendon/ligament injuries.

The most common tendon to be injured is the superficial digital flexor tendon, usually in the cannon region. While galloping, the fetlock joint sinks significantly, which is when the strain through this tendon is greatest. This perhaps explains why injury to the superficial digital flexor tendon is most common in racehorses and event horses.

Tackling tendon injuries | Horse and Rider

Tendinitis is inflammation or irritation of a tendon — the thick fibrous cords that attach muscle to bone. The condition causes pain and tenderness just outside a joint. While tendinitis can occur in any of your tendons, it's most common around your shoulders, elbows, wrists, knees and heels.

The issue with tendons is that they have very little blood flow, which makes healing an issue. Thus in general, simply not using the hand will not fix the problem (at least not in a reasonable time period.) You essentially need to aggravate the tendon to stimulate blood flow and healing, but not so much aggravation that you make it worse.

Training with a finger pulley/flexor tendon issue

The most common cause of a flexor tendon injury is a deep cut to the palm or the finger (s). When cut, the tendon acts like a rubber band, and the end pulls away from one another. When this happens it becomes impossible to bend your finger (s). If a tendon is partially cut, the finger may still bend a little.

Tendon Injury Tendon injury can occur via external trauma, either hard blunt trauma, such as a leg being caught under a plank in the fence (or even due to a slipped bandage), or mechanical overload.

Flexor tendon reconstruction indications are somewhat controversial, but it is generally accepted as an option when primary repair has failed, when a flexor tendon injury is missed, and for crush injuries, contaminated injuries, open fractures, skin deficiencies, and considerably scarred digits.
