Mecca's recorded origins are vague, but evidence suggests it existed as early as 30 BC, when Greek historian Diodorus Siculus wrote of Bakkah and a holy shrine revered by inhabitants in a narrow valley on the Arabian Peninsula. Islamic tradition holds that Mecca dates back even further, to 2000 BC, when Ibrahim (Abraham) rebuilt the Kaaba (House of God), the holy shrine that all Muslims face when performing prayers five times a day.
